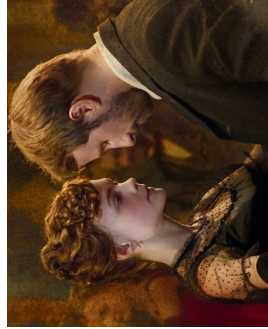

Filmed at: Durdle Door, Dorset

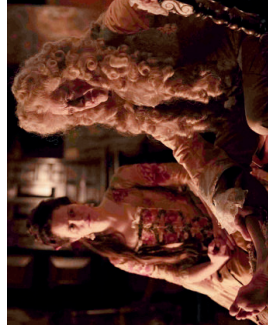


17 JULY 18:00
